FAQ: When is the first day of school?

Tuesday, August 25th!

FAQ: What time does school start and end?

8:25 am through 2:55 pm daily

ON WEDNESDAYS, early dismissal at 1:55 pm each week

FAQ: What are the prices for student meals?

Breakfast: \$1.15

Reduced Breakfast (K-3): \$ 0.00

Reduced Breakfast (4-5): \$ 0.00

Lunch: \$2.25

Reduced Lunch (K-3): \$ 0.00

Reduced Lunch (4-5): \$.40

FAQ: What bus will my child ride, and what will their pick-up and drop-off stop be?

All buses and routes that service Prospect Point attendance area students will be listed on the school district website.

Please review this information before school begins as there have been many changes. Busing will be available starting on the first day of school. Kindergartners will not be eligible to begin bus service until their first full day at school on either August 31st or September 1st.
